24th April 1915

1. 1st Objective - The line points 141-138-114
2. I. R. D. F. Villages of Sudd El Bahr & Hill 141
I. R. M. F. Villages exclusive to Fort 2 inclusive.
I. L. F. Trenches & Reservoir on hill 138.
One Co. to assist 2. R. F. in taking Hill 141
2. R. F. Hill 114 & secure flank towards NE.
3. A & B Co I. L. F. will take hill 138 -
Right of A Co directing on pt 138,
B Co. on immediate left of A Co.
Machine guns will accompany A+B Co
& assist ~~advance~~ They ~~can~~ the advance of B Co.
A Co. will connect with left of R. M. F.
C Co. will go to the left on landing
but will keep connection with A+B Co
and will assist 2. R. F. in taking Hill 114
by their fire.
D Co. less 2 platoons will remain with
O. C. I. L. F. standing in Reserve

4. Bds H.Q. when established will be at Light-House & 2 Orderlies will be sent there soon after landing, giving situation of unit.
5. Central Military Base Signal Station on Beach W.
Hank signal stations will be established subsequently on or near Hills 141 & 114.
6. The 2nd Landing party under Capt. TALLENTS will be responsible for carrying all tools to the firing line when required.
The surplus ammunition will be carried by the Regt. Ammunition carriers under the Acting Sgnt. Major.
7. The position of O.C. I.L.F. will be notified later.
8. As soon as the M.O. has selected his 1st Aid Station he will inform O.C. ⁵⁶

1. Our line has been established from P²³⁶ to Tatta Battery to River mouth Sq/168
L.H. 28-4-15
2. The 58th Bde will dig in on this line on a support to the attack on KRITHIA, from the Telegraph line Sq 169 & on our right.
3. Sections allotted as follows:—
 * I RIF from Telegraph line to road inclusive on 200' band.
 I RIF from road exclusive for 400' N.W.
 I LF from left of I RIF to 200' west of stream
 2 RIF from left of I LF to sea
4. At 8 a.m. Battalions will march independently to their sections and begin work on arrival.
5. Reports to H^o Q^{rs} in 168 J 6
6. Trenches have already been begun on line named, which will be further extended & improved.
7. Next objective P²³⁶, Knob NE of KRITHIA, 176 & 1, 184 & 8
